

CONTENT NEUTRAL ANALYSIS

1. Ask whether the regulation is really an attempt to suppress a message because of its content.
2. If it is not, then determine whether the restriction it imposes on speech is outweighed by its promotion of significant governmental interests.

REGULATION OF SPEECH IN PUBLIC FORUM

Must Be

1. Content neutral
2. Narrowly tailored to serve significant governmental interest.
3. Leave open ample alternative channels of communication

TRADITIONAL PUBLIC FORUMS

1. Streets
2. Parks
3. Sidewalks
